Youth MHFA instructor training: extension programme

Who is it for?

The Youth MHFA instructor training programme is for people who wish to deliver the Youth MHFA course. The Youth MHFA course is aimed at adults who live, work or care for young people aged 11-18.

This extension programme is especially for approved MHFA instructors. You are an approved MHFA instructor if you have completed the MHFA instructor training programme, have delivered two MHFA courses and have been signed off by your mentor. If you train to be a Youth MHFA instructor, you can continue to be an MHFA instructor as well.

How does it differ to the Youth MHFA instructor training programme and how much does it cost?

The extension programme lasts for four days and assumes you can already deliver the MHFA course to a high standard. The extension programme is £1,100 + VAT per place.
